CEO's MESSAGE



On 3/9/2018, the Minister of Water, Land and Natural Resources (KATS), YB Dr. Xavier Jayakumar publicly thanked the new Kedah State Government for putting an end to logging activities in the 163,103-hectare Greater Ulu Muda Forest Complex (Ulu Muda).

Ulu Muda is the most important water catchment area in North Malaysia. Its rainforests catch about 70% of Perlis raw water, 96% of Kedah's raw water and more than 80% of Penang's raw water.

About 4.09 million Malaysians living in our 3 northern states, as well as all the businesses that operate here, are highly dependent on the rain water caught by the rainforests of Ulu Muda.

Announcing a total ban on logging in Ulu Muda is a good start. However, Ulu Muda deserves to be conserved, properly and sustainably.

Now that the Malaysian Federal Government has acknowledged the

importance of Ulu Muda, the next measures to be taken are to:

- Introduce a Federal law that provides legal protection to Ulu Muda as a "Northern Region Water Catchment Area" in perpetuity;
- Establish a Federal department to monitor and manage Ulu Muda, not only as a rainforest area, but as a regional water catchment area; and
- Provide Federal compensation to Kedah to conserve Ulu Muda, not only for Kedah, but for Perlis and Penang as well.

Kindly note that 3 key factors set Ulu Muda apart from all other rainforest areas in Malaysia:

1. It is the only regional water catchment area that serves 3 states;
2. There is no existing replacement for Ulu Muda as a regional water catchment area; and

3. Any negative development in Ulu Muda will adversely affect water supply services and all socioeconomic activities in North Malaysia.

In other words, Ulu Muda is a priceless and irreplaceable natural asset that "serves" Perlis, Kedah and Penang. Now is a good time to act, constructively and convincingly, to conserve it as such.

The Federal Government should protect Ulu Muda, not only for the birds and the trees. It should conserve Ulu Muda sustainably for the benefit of 4.09 million people living in Perlis, Kedah and Penang...and the next generations.

PBAPP melalui akademinya, Penang Water Services Academy (PWSA) telah dipilih untuk menjadi tuan rumah bagi mempromosikan program Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM) melalui kaedah Pengiktirafan Pencapaian Terdahulu (PPT) untuk kakitangan industri bekalan air Malaysia.

Majlis yang dianjurkan oleh Malaysian Water Association (MWA) itu diadakan pada 30 Julai 2018 bertempat di Tingkat 5, KOMTAR, Jalan Penang Pulau Pinang. Seramai 50 peserta hadir ke majlis tersebut yang terdiri daripada kakitangan Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd dan Syarikat Air Perlis Sdn Bhd.

Majlis dirasmikan oleh Y.Bhg Datuk Ir. Abdul Kadir Bin Mohd Din, Pengerusi The Malaysian Water Association (MWA). Turut hadir Y.Bhg Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif PBA Holdings Bhd serta En. Mohd Faris Jamaludin, wakil daripada Jabatan Pembangunan Kemahiran (JPK) dan Dr. Hapidah Mohamad, Pengarah Latihan MWA.

Program ini membolehkan para pekerja berpengalaman dan mahir untuk mendapatkan pensijilan peringkat SKM tanpa perlu menjalani latihan Vokasional formal atau sepenuh masa. Pada akhir program, para peserta dikehendaki melengkapkan borang permohonan program SKM-PPT dan menyerahkan kepada pengatur dan seterusnya melayakkan para peserta memiliki SKM.

Malaysia perlu membangunkan kumpulan pekerja industri bekalan air yang kompeten, bagi menangani cabaran seperti perubahan iklim, sumber air mentah yang terhad, pertambahan dalam akaun air setiap tahun dan peningkatan permintaan air.

Bagi operator bekalan air, margin untuk kesilapan manusia akan sentiasa rendah, manakala impak sosial dan kos ekonomi untuk kesilapan itu akan sentiasa tinggi. Dalam konteks ini, latihan kompetensi dan pensijilan adalah keperluan kritikal untuk mengekalkan perkhidmatan bekalan air yang baik.

Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd memenangi 2 Anugerah Emas (Kelas I) oleh Persatuan Keselamatan dan Kesihatan Pekerjaan Malaysia (MSOSH).

Anugerah emas adalah untuk pencapaian kemalangan sifar "LTI", kemalangan dan kejadian berbahaya di Loji-loji Rawatan (LRA) Air Batu Ferringhi dan Bukit Toh Allang dalam tahun 2017.

Inilah kali pertama PBAPP menerima anugerah MSOSH Gold (Kelas I).

Pada asasnya, anugerah ini menunjukkan operasi bekalan air dan persekitaran kerja di dua LRA ini adalah antara yang paling selamat dan paling sihat di kalaangan syarikat utiliti di Malaysia. PULAU PINANG MENGALU-ALUKAN LANGKAH MENGHARAMKAN PEMBALAKAN DI ULU MUDA

1 September 2018

Pulau Pinang dan PBAPP mengalu-alukan pengumuman pembalakan diharamkan di hutan hujan Ulu Muda di Kedah.

Menteri Air, Tanah dan Sumber Asli (KATS), YB Dr. Xavier Jayakumar, dipetik oleh media massa *online* dan cetak pada 4/9/2018 dan 5/9/2018, sebagai berkata bahawa Kerajaan Negeri Kedah telah bersetuju untuk larangan pembalakan di Ulu Muda.

Dalam konteks ini, terima kasih diucapkan kepada Menteri Besar Kedah, YAB Dato' Seri Haji Mukhriz Mahathir, kerana keputusan penting ini. Begitu juga kepada YB Dr. Xavier kerana memudahkan perkara ini dilaksanakan.

Langkah melarang pembalakan di Ulu Muda ini dapat melindungi kawasan tадahan air yang paling penting untuk tiga negeri utara iaitu Perlis, Kedah dan Pulau Pinang.

Walau bagaimanapun, ia perlu disokong oleh undang-undang iaitu dengan mewartakan undang-undang untuk melindungi Ulu Muda sebagai kawasan tадahan air, memastikan perlindungan undang-undang meliputi keseluruhan kawasan hutan hujan Ulu Muda yang merangkumi 163,103 hektar dan mewujudkan agensi penguatkuasaan untuk menguatkuasakan undang-undang.

Tindakan tegas dan segera yang diambil oleh Kerajaan Negeri Pakatan Harapan Kedah dan Kerajaan Persekutuan yang baru ini adalah sesuatu yang amat positif yang berniat baik.

Berita baik itu sememangnya telah dinantikan untuk sekian lama. Apabila ia benar-benar diumumkan, perlindungan Ulu Muda harus dibuat "secara rasmi" dengan prosiding undang-undang dan peruntukan yang sewajarnya untuk memastikan hutan hujan dilindungi secukupnya sebagai kawasan tадahan air bagi kita semua serta generasi seterusnya.





ASIA PACIFIC MASTERS GAMES OPENING CEREMONY RUN

8 September 2018

A total of 70 members from PBA Sports & Recreational Club participated in the 2018 Asia Pacific Masters Games Opening Ceremony Run held on 8 September 2018 at Padang Kota Lama, Penang. The team members completed the 5 km run and successfully brought back the medal as a symbol of success for those who took part.

The Asia Pacific Masters Games 2018 (APMG 2018) were held from 7-15 September 2018 in Penang. A total of 22 sports were contested. More than 10,000 participants from around the world joined the APMG Penang 2018. APMG is an International Multi-Sport Events which holds the similar standard as the Olympic and Asian Games. Hence, it is devoted to delivering similar platforms and experiences as the world-class games to all who participated in APMG 2018. APMG is a regional multi-sport event which involves participants from the Asia-Pacific region.

APMG is recognised by the International Masters Games Association (IMGA) and the International Olympic Committee in order to ensure the standard of APMG 2018.





MENGKUANG DAM VISIT BY PENANG CHIEF MINISTER

8 September 2018



Penang Chief Minister, YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow made a first visit to Mengkuang Dam on 8 September 2018, to get first-hand information and to view the Mengkuang Dam Expansion Project (MDEP).

Speaking to the media during the visit, YAB Chief Minister said that Penang is seeking the assistance of the Ministry of Water, Land and Natural Resources (KATS) to expedite works that will ensure the safety and functionality of the Mengkuang Dam Expansion Project (MDEP).

YAB Tuan Chow said that on 4/9/2018, he had a meeting with YB Dr. Xavier Jayakumar and a KATS delegation, where a few issues were raised :

- Penang would like to re-open the Mengkuang Dam to the public as a people-friendly recreational area. However, there are 23 landslide sites in the dam environment that have not been repaired.
- Raw water needs to be pumped up from Sungai Kulim to fill up the Mengkuang Dam. However, the Mak Sulong Pumping Station is not functional yet, and, as such, has not been commissioned.
- The Mengkuang Dam has been expanded to store up to 73.5 billion litres of water. However, the structural integrity of the dam cannot be ascertained until it is filled up to its maximum level of 55 meters.



He added that having a larger Mengkuang Dam is not enough. Penang needs the Mak Sulong Pumping Station to help fill up the dam during wet seasons. The 6.85km of new pipelines are also needed to deliver up to 600 MLD of raw water from the dam to the Sungai Dua WTP during dry seasons.

Penang needs a fully functional and safe MDEP to meet all the water supply needs of its people beyond 2020.

The second award is the Malaysia Water Award for Management 2018 for PBAHB & PBAPP CEO Dato’ Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa, in recognition of his outstanding management in the fields of water or wastewater engineering.


