PBAPP RECEIVES IKM "LABORATORY EXCELLENCE AWARD" FOR THE 2ND CONSECUTIVE YEAR 7 December 2018

Institut Kimia Malaysia (IKM) has presented Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP) with its "Laboratory Excellence Award" for the second consecutive year. This award recognises the performance of the PBAPP Central Laboratory in the Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant (Sg Dua WTP) in 2018.

IKM audited the laboratory on 23.8.2018, and handed over the award to PBAPP during its "Malam Kimia Gala Dinner" at the Royale Chulan Damansara Hotel in Petaling Jaya on 7.12.2018.

Last year, PBAPP received its first "Laboratory Excellence Award" from IKM on 8.12.2017. The IKM award recognises PBAPP's commitment to competent analytical testing of water, in accordance to the MS ISO/IEC 17025:2005 standards.

Headed by 2 chemists, the 13-personnel team at the Central Laboratory in the Sg Dua WTP is tasked with the responsibility of testing the quality of raw water, settled water and treated water.

These testing procedures help to ensure that PBAPP consistently produces treated water that exceeds the parameters set in the Quality Assurance Programme (QAP) by the Malaysian Ministry of Health (MOH).



PBAPP'S ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH & SAFETY WEEK 2019 (EHS WEEK 2019) 22-25 April 2019

PBAPP's Environment, Health & Safety Week 2019 (EHS Week 2019) was organised at various locations from 22 to 25 April 2019. The Safety and Health Unit organized three acitivities. EHS Week 2019 was officiated by Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa, the Chief Executive Officer of PBAPP and PBA Holdings Bhd at PBAPP's Rifle Range Complex.

A road safety talk, 'Program Keselamatan Jalan Raya' was conducted by Jabatan Keselamatan Jalan Raya (JKJR), followed by a motorcycle riding demonstration by HONDA. This talk was to promote the responsibilities of road users to ride/drive safely and as a measure to reduce the number of accidents involving employees of PBAPP. Free motorcycle helmets and "goodie bags" were given away to participants who took part in the quiz session. An information booth was set up for attendees to check out the latest activities conducted by JKJR.



The final day of the event took place at Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant where three safety talks were conducted.

These talks were conducted to accommodate the Systematic Occupational Health Enhancement Level Programme (So-Help) programme's requirement on educating the production staff of Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant and other water treatment plants on the elements of Chemical, Noise and Ergonomics. Two guest speakers from DOSH Seberang Jaya were invited to give a talk on Chemical Safety and Hearing Conservation. A consultant for the QSH Department gave a talk on Ergonomics.

A competition was held where eligible production staff were selected to take part in the Knowledge Quest Competition. Participants from ten teams competed to the top five positions, winning cash prizes worth of RM1700.

The event ended successfully along with the other programmes conducted by the other units from the QSH Department.

TALKS BY PENANG GREEN COUNCIL (PGC)

QSH arranged for talks on **Waste Segregation at Source and Taking Ownership on Our Waste Footprint** talks during EHS Week. The two talks were delivered at Rifle Range Complex and Prai Complex respectively. The talks were given by Ms Kimberly from Penang Green Council.

PBAPP Rifle Range Complex - 22 April 2019

Taking ownership on our waste footprint with focus on single use plastics. Participants were also briefed on quantity of waste produced (plastics) and waste management (plastic) in Penang. The talk continued with impacts of our waste footprints for environmental, animal & biodiversity, human & living environment and economy & social.

Three new terms on 3R was introduced to the participants. The new 3R are **Rehabilitate**, **Rethink** and **Refuse**.



PBAPP Prai Complex - 24 April 2019

Waste segregation at source focused on type of wastes, disposal types, effects and consequences, how to segregate waste and importance of waste segregation at source. This talk highlighted on what should be our direction for future. The direction is to focus more on **Rethink** and **Refuse**. **Rethink** should be "our consumption rate is sustainable" while **Refuse** should be on "product that is not reusable". Example of **Refuse** is single use plastics.

PBAPP ENVIRONMENT PHOTO CONTEST

The photography contest was organized by Quality, Health and Safety Department in conjuction with Environment, Health and Safety week. HARI AIR SEDUNIA PERINGKAT NEGERI PULAU PINANG 2019 27 April 2019



Sambutan Hari Air Sedunia pada tahun ini yang berlangsung di Taman Rekreasi Bukit Dumbar, Georgetown menarik lebih 500 pengunjung. Pada tahun ini, tema "Save Water, Think About Our Future" atau "Jimat Air, Fikirkan Masa Hadapan Kita" dipilih untuk memastikan penggunapengguna di Pulau Pinang terus berusaha untuk menjimatkan penggunaan air untuk generasi akan datang.

Majlis sambutan yang dianjurkan oleh Water Watch Penang ini bermula seawal jam 7.30 pagi dengan pendaftaran peserta pertandingan melukis. Walaupun cuaca hujan pada awal pagi, ia tidak menghalang peserta dan pengunjung untuk mengambil peluang hadir pada acara ini.

Selain pertandingan melukis, gerai pameran berkaitan sumber dan bekalan air juga turut berlangsung.

Gerai pameran PBAPP turut memaparkan Peranti Penjimatan Air dan aplikasi MyPBA. Sambutan kali ini dirasmikan oleh YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow, Ketua Menteri Pulau Pinang.

Ketika ucapan perasmian, YAB Tuan Chow berkata Pulau Pinang sangat memerlukan sumber air mentah kedua atau alternatif, untuk memenuhi permintaan air yang semakin meningkat. Penggunaan air negeri adalah 840 juta liter sehari (MLD) pada tahun 2018; dan dijangka mencapai 1,884 MLD menjelang 2050.



SPRWTS adalah solusi terbaik kerana:

- 1. Ia merupakan projek yang akan memanfaatkan dua buah negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang dan Perak.
- 2. Ia boleh menjamin bekalan air di Pulau Pinang dan Perak Utara sehingga tahun 2050. Dengan kata lain, ia adalah penyelesaian yang berpanjangan.
- 3. Kos pembangunannya adalah lebih rendah berbanding kos pembangunan untuk kitar-semula air, projek penuaian air hujan dan penyahgaraman pada skala yang sama.



- 4. Dari segi kos operasi, SPRWTS adalah lebih menjimatkan kos daripada kitar-semula air, penuaian air hujan dan penyahgaraman.
- 5. Memandangkan ia merupakan projek penyaluran air mentah antara negeri, sebahagian dari SPRWTS akan dibiayai oleh Kerajaan Persekutuan.

Sementara Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif PBAPP dan PBA Holdings Bhd, Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa pula berkata dalam tempoh 2019 - 2021, PBAPP merancang melabur sebanyak RM501 juta dalam projek bekalan air untuk masa depan.

3 projek utama itu adalah:

 Saluran Paip Dasar Laut Berkembar Ketiga Butterworth ke Pulau Pinang

Projek ini terdiri daripada saluran paip dasar laut berkembar berdiameter 1200mm yang membolehkan PBAPP membekalkan 315 juta liter sehari (MLD) air dari Loji Rawatan Air Sungai Dua di Seberang Prai ke Pulau Pinang.

- Skim Penyaluran Air Mentah Sungai Perak (SPRWTS) Pulau Pinang telah terlalu lama bergantung kepada hanya satu sumber air mentah utama, Sungai Muda. Pulau Pinang perlu meneroka sumber air mentah kedua untuk memenuhi permintaan air pada masa hadapan selepas tahun 2025. SPRWTS akan dilaksanakan dalam 4 fasa sehingga Tahun 2040, dengan pengeluaran keseluruhan 1,000 MLD.
- Menaik taraf 9 Loji Rawatan Air Sedia Ada Adalah lebih murah dan lebih baik untuk menaik taraf loji rawatan air di Pulau Pinang daripada membina loji rawatan air baru. PBAPP akan mengoptimumkan pengeluaran air terawat untuk melengahkan masa, sehingga SPRWTS dimulakan.

Being "water-friendly" has paid off for 10 organisations and 19 schools. Their representatives received cash rewards and incentives totaling RM30,250 from PBAPP.

These rewards and incentives were handed out by Penang Chief Minister YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow at the "Green Pinang Awards Presentation Ceremony" dinner at the Sunway Hotel, Seberang Jaya. Also present were PBA Holdings Bhd and PBAPP Chief Executive Officer Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa, and Penang Green Council (PGC) General Manager Ms. Thing Siew Shuen.

The 10 water-efficient organisations received special cash rewards were the second-time recipients of PBAPP's "Aqua Save" certification. These organisations received between RM500.00 and RM2000.00 for successfully renewing their Aqua Save certifications in 2018.

Meanwhile, another 5 organisations also received their first-time Aqua Save certifications from YAB Tuan Chow.

The "Aqua Save" programme is a PBAPP initiative to promote sustainable water conservation amongst business and non-business organisations in Penang. Under this programme, "Aqua Save" certifications (valid for 2 years) are given to organisations which have implemented efficient and effective water saving measures or technologies.

Organisations which are able to renew their certifications for an additional 2 years are given special cash rewards. "Aqua Save" is being implemented in collaboration with the Penang State Government, through the Penang Green Council (PGC).

PBA Holdings Berhad (PBAHB) hosted its 19th Annual General Meeting (AGM) on Thursday, 30 May 2019 at the Pinang Ballroom, Hotel Jen, Penang.

Promptly at 10.00am, the share and proxy holders, guests and Board Members were seated as YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow, the Chairman of PBAHB, called the meeting to order.

A total of 1,053 shareholders and proxyholders attended the meeting. The 19th AGM approved a single tier final dividend of 1.75 sen per share for the financial year 2018. Accordingly, the total dividend paid and declared by PBAHB for FY2018 amounts to 3.5 sen per share. On 11.1.2019, the company had paid a first interim dividend of 1.75 sen per share.



PBAHB recorded a profit before tax (PBT) of RM36.137 million in 2018, as compared to RM40.936 million in 2017.

PBAHB's revenue was primarily generated from the sale of potable water in Penang by its principal subsidiary, Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP).

It should be noted that PBAPP billed the lowest domestic water tariffs in Malaysia in 2018, at an average of RM0.32 per 1,000 litres for the first 35,000 litres per month, as compared to the national average of RM0.69 per 1,000 litres in 2017.

2018 was another successful year for PBAHB and PBAPP in terms of providing an essential public service; as well as in terms of sustaining a strong financial standing.

As at 31.12.2018, PBAHB held cash and cash equivalents valued at RM182.48 million while its retained profits amounted to RM368.31 million.

The 19th AGM approved all the 14 resolutions tabled by its Board of Directors.

On 1.5.2019, a Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP) team, comprising 80 personnel, won the "Champion Contingent" award in the 2019 National Workers' Day Celebration.

PRIME MINISTER'S AWARD FOR DATO' IR. JASENI MAIDINSA

Prime Minister Tun Dr. Mahathir bin Mohamad presented the "Anugerah Perdana Menteri Tokoh Mahir 2019" (APMTM 2019) to Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa, the CEO of PBA Holdings Bhd (PBAHB) and Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP).

Dato' Ir. Jaseni received the award at the Putrajaya International Convention Centre on 1 May 2019, in conjunction with the 2019 National Worker's Day Celebrations.

The APMTM 2019 recognises Dato' Ir. Jaseni's key contributions in championing, developing and promoting competency training programmes for the water supply industry in Malaysia.

The APMTM is awarded to individuals who have contributed significantly to skills development in the nation. Recipients are recommended by the Department of Skills Development (Jabatan Pembangunan Kemahiran - JPK) in the Ministry of Human Resource (MoHR). The final approval comes from the Prime Minister.

Dato' Ir. Jaseni's key contributions in promoting and facilitating competency training or the water supply industry include:

 Launching the Penang Water Services Academy (PWSA) in 2007, as the first water supply services training academy in Malaysia, and overseeing its management since then. PWSA is also the first water supply services academy that was accredited by JPK to conduct SKM-level competency training in Malaysia.



- Helping JPK to develop the skills standards and occupational framework for "Malaysian Skills Certificate" (Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia - SKM) training programmes for the water supply industry. SKM graduates are recognised by the National Water Services Commission (SPAN) as competent and skilled workers for the industry.
- Assessing and verifying the competency of SKM candidates seeking certification under the "Recognition of Prior Achievement" (Pengiktirafan Pencapaian Terdahulu – PPT) programme.

PENANG WATER SERVICES ACADEMY SETS UP A BRANCH CAMPUS IN **KUALA LUMPUR**

PBA Resources Sdn Bhd (PBAR) has signed a collaborative agreement with the Malaysian Water Academy Sdn Bhd (MyWA) to further promote and provide technical competency training for the Malaysian water supply industry. PBAR, a 100% owned subsidiary of PBA Holdings Bhd, manages the Penang Water Services Academy (PWSA).

Through the agreement, MyWA, which is based in Kuala Lumpur, becomes a PWSA branch campus that provides PWSA training programmes.

As a PWSA branch campus, MyWA is now able to help more school-leavers and water supply industry personnel to obtain technical competency certifications. This is the second "smart partnership" agreement that PBAR has signed to promote technical competency certifications throughout Malaysia.

In November 2016, the National Water Services Commission (SPAN) set a key performance indicator (KPI) for water supply operators to obtain competency certifications for all their technical personnel. This KPI is related to Section (49)1 of the Water Services

Industry Act 2006 (WSIA 2006). The minimum competency certifications are SKM certifications.

To date, no water supply organisation has achieved 100% compliance to this SPAN KPI. Penang is aiming to become the first state to comply to this KPI by the end of 2019. In doing so, it will also become the first state to achieve 100% technical personnel competency in the Malaysian water supply industry.

"ASIAWATER" CHOOSES PENANG WATER TREATMENT PLANT AS INDUSTRY TECHNICAL VISIT SITE 18 April 2019

The Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant (WTP) in Seberang Prai will serve as the industry technical visit site for the "Asiawater 2020" Expo & Forum next year. This is the first time that a Penang water treatment plant has been selected as an Asiawater industry technical visit site.

Asiawater 2020 advisor Datuk Teo Yen Hua said in line with the event's theme 'Embracing Change,Pursuing Excellence', the organisers have decided to choose Penang for its excellent performance in water management.

30 visitors were taken on a site visit at the plant as part of the Asiawater's media tour and marketing campaign in promoting water management and conservation for adequate, safe and affordable water services and preserving the environment.

They spent over an hour touring the plant's Package 12 section to understand how raw water was brought in, filtered and cleaned through multiple processes, and visited the command centre equipped with state-of-the-art data server, a 10-screen video wall, as well as hardware and software to monitor electronic data from key treated water installations.

Majlis Menandatangani Perjanjian Kolektif (CA) di antara Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP) dengan Kesatuan Kakitangan PBAPP dan Kesatuan Pekerja-pekerja PBAPP telah diadakan pada 26 Mac 2019 lalu di Hotel Jen.

Perjanjian Kolektif ke-7 ini berkuatkuasa mulai 1 Januari 2018 hingga 31 Disember 2020.

YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow, selaku Pengerusi Kumpulan Syarikat PBA, hadir menyaksikan majlis menandatangani CA kali ini. Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif, Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa dan Ketua Divisyen Sumber Manusia, Encik Mohamed Zulkifli Abdul Hamid menandatangani bagi pihak PBAPP manakala Yang Dipertua Kesatuan Kakitangan PBAPP, En. S. Kugasaravanamoothy dan Yang Dipertua Kesatuan Pekerja-pekerja PBAPP, Mohd. Adlin bin Ali serta kedua-dua setiausaha mewakili pihak kesatuan.

Sebelum mencapai kata sepakat, rundingan tawar menawar telah bermula sejak bulan Januari 2018 dan berakhir pada 8 Mac 2019 dan merupakan satu proses yang agak mencabar.

Kedua-dua pihak iaitu Pengurusan dan Kesatuan telah mengadakan 10 kali rundingan dengan kedua-dua Kesatuan dalam mencari penyelesaian bagi setiap artikel yang dirundingkan.

Menerusi Perjanjian Kolektif ke-tujuh ini, ahli-ahli kesatuan akan memperolehi faedah di antaranya seperti berikut:

- Faedah Bersalin sebanyak RM1,500 diperuntukkan bagi bayaran kemasukan ke Hospital Panel Swasta bagi setiap kelahiran (maksimum lima kali kelahiran).
- Cuti Isteri Bersalin, kakitangan akan menikmati Cuti Isteri Bersalin sebanyak tiga hari secara berturut-turut tidak termasuk hari rehat dan cuti umum.
- Bayaran Cermin Mata di mana pihak Syarikat akan menanggung kos bayaran balik Cermin Mata bagi pekerja sahaja di mana ianya akan ditolak dari peruntukan buku rawatan RM2,500 setahun.
- Anugerah Perkhidmatan, penambahan bagi satu lagi kategori iaitu 20 tahun perkhidmatan di mana Cenderahati sebanyak RM1,000 akan diberikan dan diikuti dengan perkhidmatan 25 tahun sebanyak RM1,500, perkhidmatan 30 tahun sebanyak RM2,000 dan perkhidmatan 35 tahun sebanyak RM2,500.





- Bantuan Untuk Pengajian Tinggi Anak-Anak Pekerja telah diberi penambahbaikan di mana anak-anak pekerja yang telah tamat pengajian di institusi tinggi dan memperolehi Purata Nilai Gred Kumulatif (CGPA) 3.0 dan ke atas akan menerima RM500 bagi Kursus Diploma dan RM1,000 bagi Kursus Ijazah.
- Hadiah Perkahwinan daripada RM200 kepada RM500 sekali dalam perkhidmatan.

Selain itu, Kakitangan PBAPP juga menikmati pelarasan gaji sebanyak 10% berkuatkuasa 1 Januari 2018 yang akan dibayar dalam gaji bulan April 2019.

PBAPP sentiasa berusaha memastikan kebajikan serta manfaat pekerja sentiasa dititik-beratkan. Syabas!

PBAPP is assisting the Melaka State Government on safety and security procedures for all water supply installations, including dams.

Seperti maahad tahfiz sebelumnya, Maahad Tahfiz Al-Aitam ini juga menempatkan anak-anak yatim dan yang kurang kemampuan bagi meneruskan penggajian persekolahan dalam jurusan agama. Untuk makluman, ketiga-tiga siri ziarah amal ini telah mendapat sokongan daripada orang ramai. Diharapkan lebih ramai yang dapat memberi sokongan melalui khidmat serta sumbangan bagi siri ziarah ini.







CONSERVE ULU MUDA, NOT ONLY FOR THE BIRDS AND THE TREES.

The Greater Ulu Muda Forest Complex (Ulu Muda) is the natural habitat for thousands of species of plants and animals. More than 4.09 million people living in Perlis, Kedah and Penang are also highly dependent on Ulu Muda as a regional water catchment area.

On 3/9/2018, the Ministry of Water, Land and Natural Resources thanked the Kedah State Government for banning all logging activities in Ulu Muda.

This is good news...but the conservation of Ulu Muda must be sustainable.

Ulu Muda should be protected, by law, for perpetuity, as a "Northern Region Water Catchment Area." It should be monitored and managed as a water catchment area, and not only as a forest area.

Most importantly, the Malaysian Federal Government should compensate Kedah for conserving Ulu Muda for the benefit of the people and businesses in 3 states: Perlis, Kedah and Penang.
