Double thumbs up for PBA

Water agency earns two national-level awards for excellence

THE Penang Water Supply Corporation (PBAPP) has received two national-level awards from the Malaysian Water Association (MWA).

The first award is the MWA Water Industry Achievement Award 2018 for 'Best Water Treatment Plant' which is the Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant (WTP).

PBAPP chief executive officer Datuk Jaseni Maidinsa said that through the years, PBAPP had carefully managed the upgrading of the Sungai Dua WTP to ensure continuous good water supply in Penang.

He added that this year, it is producing more than 80% of the treated water that is distributed throughout the state daily.

"Today, the Sungai Dua plant is the largest WTP in the country with a maximum treated water capacity of 1,228 million litres per day (MLD) and its principal supply area is Seberang Prai.

"Its treated water is also pumped to the island via two sets of twin submarine pipelines.

"It is one of Penang's most important, advanced and efficient water supply asset," he said.

The second award is the Malaysia Water Award for Management 2018 which recognises outstanding management in the fields of water or wastewater engineering.
