PBAPP LIGHTS UP THE BUKIT DUMBAR RECREATION PARK

- 6 units of 140W LED lights and 25 units of 65W LED lights installed, as per the Penang State Government's request to light up the park.
- Road works and other miscellaneous works completed to make Bukit Dumbar Recreation Park more "people-friendly".

PENANG, Tuesday (13/3/2018): Penang Chief Minister YAB Tuan Lim Guan Eng gave Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP) the thumbs up today for completing works to light up the Bukit Dumbar Recreation Park.

He visited the park today to inspect the following completed works:

- 1. Installation of 6 units of 140W LED lights on 14-metre light poles;
- 2. Installation of 25 units of 65W LED lights on 6-metre light poles;
- 3. Rectification and re-surfacing of road unevenness;
- 4. Refurbishment of a reservoir top jogging track; and
- 5. Repairs on playground equipment.

YAB Lim said the Penang State Government had asked PBAPP to light up and refurbish the Bukit Dumbar Recreation Park so that it may serve as a "people-friendly park."

"This State Government promotes a Cleaner, Greener and Healthier Penang. As such, we do our best to provide people-friendly green spaces wherein Penangites may exercise and workout; relax and unwind; and spend quality time with their families and friends," he said.



Meanwhile, PBAPP and PBA Holdings Bhd CEO Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa said the lighting works were completed at a cost of RM196,270.00, while the road and miscellaneous works cost an additional RM122,941.00.

"This means that PBAPP is investing a total of RM319,211.00 in this corporate social responsibility, or CSR, project at the Bukit Dumbar Recreational Park," he said. "We hope that the park users will enjoy the value-added features in the park, and make use these features responsibly."
