CASH REWARDS FROM PBAPP FOR SAVING WATER

• PBAPP provided cash incentives totalling of RM19,750 to "green schools" and organisations for implementing water conservation projects.

PENANG, Thursday, 21.11.2019: 18 "green" schools and 6 organisations received cash incentives totalling RM19,750 from Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP) for their water conservation efforts today.

The recipients were participants in PBAPP's "Penang Green School Aqua Save Programme" and the "Aqua Save" water conservation initiative, implemented in collaboration with the Penang State Government and the Penang Green Council (PGC).

YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow, the Chief Minister of Penang, handed out the rewards to the recipients during the "Penang Green Awards Ceremony 2019" held in the Wembley Hotel here today.

Dato' Ir. Jaseni Maidinsa, the CEO of PBAPP and PBA Holdings Bhd, who was also present at the event, said:.

"Penang is a successful state, but we must remember that we are also a water-stressed state. Our geographical footprint is only 1,048 sq. km. With limited land space, we have limited raw water resources.

"And yet, our per capita domestic water consumption is the highest in Malaysia. In 2018, Penang's per capita domestic consumption was 278 litres/capita/day (I/c/d), as compared to the national average of 210 I/c/d. Meanwhile, Singapore achieved 143 I/c/d in 2017."

He said PBAPP was continuously upgrading water supply infrastructure to stay ahead of Penang's water demand. "However, the expenditure is high and it runs into hundreds of millions of ringgit. Please note that high water infrastructure investments will ultimately lead towards high water tariffs," he added.



Dato' Ir. Jaseni encouraged the people and businesses in Penang to use water more wisely.

"If you can reduce your water consumption, we can reduce expenditure for new water infrastructure projects. We call this demand management. It is the cheaper, greener and less wasteful way to sustain good water supply services for all in Penang In the future," he said.

He said public water conservation was the "green way" to ensure that the state has sufficient water to achieve the Penang 2030 Vision of becoming a "family-focused green and smart state that inspires the nation".

PBAPP launched its "Aqua Save" initiative in 2009.

"Aqua Save is part of our commitment to promote the concept of water conservation inside Penang's schools, work places and organisational premises. We believe in encouraging as many Penangites to save water, in as many places as possible; so that more people may develop the habit of saving water, 24/7," Dato' Ir. Jaseni said.

The 18 "green schools" that received cash incentives totalling RM14,250.00 had adopted the "Aqua Save" programme as part of their criteria for assessment in the PGC's "Penang Green School Awards" 2019.

Meanwhile, the 6 organisations who received cash incentives totalling RM5,500 today were organisations which had successfully renewed their two-year "Aqua Save" certificates with PBAPP. This year, 18 other organisations also received new "Aqua Save" certifications.
