## PBAPP WILL COORDINATE MOBILISATION OF 99 TANKERS DURING THE JANUARY 2024 SCHEDULED WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION (SWSI)

- The fleet of tankers will include 27 "Jumbo Tankers" (40,000L).
- In addition, PBAPP will deploy 19 "Gajah Flexitanks" (24,000L), or parked water containers, and 78 normal static water tanks in affected areas.
- These temporary water distribution assets will be mobilised/deployed in accordance to PBAPP's 4-stage water supply recovery plan.

PENANG, Saturday, 6 January 2024: Perbadanan Bekalan Air Pulau Pinang Sdn Bhd (PBAPP) will deploy a fleet of 99 water tankers to deliver water to affected consumers during the January 2024 scheduled water supply interruption (SWSI).

This is the largest fleet of water tankers to be deployed in Penang's water supply history. It will include 27 rented "Jumbo Tankers" which can store up to 40,000L (litres) of treated water.

## "Flexitanks" and Static Water Tanks

Other than the tanker fleet, PBAPP is also installing a total of 97 static water tanks to store water for collection by affected consumers during the January 2024 SWSI. These water tanks include rented "Gajah Flexitanks" that have a maximum capacity of 24,000L per tank.

Please note that the "Gajah Flexitanks" and static tanks installed by PBAPP are **in addition to** the water tanks that are put in place by the respective State Assemblywomen/ Assemblymen (ADUNs) and Members of Parliament (MPs).

All statics tanks (including tanks set up by ADUNs and MPs) will be refilled regularly by the water tanker fleet. PBAPP is planning to supply about 1.85 million litres of treated water per day (MLD) via the water tanker fleet and static tanks during the 4-day SWSI from 6.00am, 10.1.2024 to 6.00am, 14.1.2024.

## Apology & Acknowledgements

Once again, PBAPP would like to apologise for all inconveniences that will be caused by the January 2024 SWSI. However, the Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant (WTP) must be temporarily shut down to replace 2 major control valves.

Kindly note that the valve replacement work is scheduled for completion in the first 24 hours. The remaining 72 hours is the timeline set to safely normalise or recover water supply services (in stages) for a total of 590,000 water consumers in Seberang Perai and Penang Island.
