## APRIL 2025 SWSI SUPPLY RECOVERY: PBAPP STRIVES ON TO STAY ON TARGET

PENANG, Sunday, 27.4.2025: Despite a delay in the completion of the Sungai Perai River-Crossing Pipeline (SP-RCP), PBAPP will continue to work towards recovering water supply for all the affected water consumers as planned.

Penang Chief Minister YAB Tuan Chow Kon Yeow has directed PBAPP to stay on target, as follows:

As at 4.00pm today, water supply has been recovered for about 228,915 consumers (70% recovery) across all 5 districts in Penang: Seberang Perai Utara (SPU), Seberang Perai Tengah (SPT), Seberang Perai Selatan (SPS), Daerah Timur Laut (DTL) and Daerah Barat Daya (DBD).

With upgraded treated water pumping infrastructure in place at various locations in the service areas of the Sungai Dua Water Treatment Plant (WTP), PBAPP will pump out as much treated water as safely possible from Penang's largest WTP over the next 24 hours.

PBAPP apologises to all affected consumers for the delay in water supply recovery.
